General rules of the Bleialf campsite

We ask you to observe a few rules that should make the stay of ALL visitors to our campsite as relaxing and pleasant as possible:

1. Access to the campsite site

Persons who are not registered on the Bleialf campsite are not authorised to enter.

Before entering the campsite for the duration of their stay, permanent campers must either register via:

- SMS
- WhatsApp,
- Facebook Messenger,
- by phone or
- by E-Mail

must be registered in advance for insurance reasons. (Telephone numbers are available at the reception or on the internet).

Visitors must sign in and out at reception before entering the campsite (this also applies to overnight stays) and pay \in 1.50 per person per day immediately. For the use of the swimming pool we charge \in 3.50 per visitor and for each overnight stay \in 5.00 per visitor. Any vehicles must be parked in the car park in front of the campsite.

By registering, you undertake to take note of these rules and to comply with them.

Doors to the forest must be kept closed at all times.

2. Reception

The opening hours of the reception can be seen in the reception window.

If reception is not staffed, the owners can be contacted at any time by telephone (+49 65 55-10 59, +32 485 894 653 or see the reception notice board).

In the leisure tent (behind the sanitary building) you can obtain information and brochures about the campsite and the sights in the surrounding area.

3. Payment

Deposits and outstanding amounts must be paid on arrival.ten.

4. <u>Identification</u>

At the request of the owner of the Bleialf campsite, every person must be able to identify themselves at all times.

In individual cases, the owner is authorised to refuse persons access to the campsite.

5. Liability

All persons (as well as children and pets) are liable for damage to site property and third parties.

persons. This also applies to theft and damage to health.

6. Complaints

If you have any complaints, please contact reception only.

7. Costs in the event of inventory damage or loss

In the event of damage (e.g. to windows, doors, furniture or third-party property, etc.), the guest must pay the full cost of repair or replacement.

8. Night rest

The campsite is closed at night from 10.00 pm to 7.30 am.

The barrier is closed from 10.00 pm to 7.30 am.

The instructions of the owner must be followed at all times.

9. Vehicles

One vehicle may be parked per rented pitch. The vehicle must be parked on your own pitch.

It is not permitted to park the vehicle on another person's pitch or on the campsite paths so that emergency vehicles such as ambulances or the fire brigade can access the site at any time.

In bad weather, please do not park on the grass (only for tent pitches). In this case, parking is possible in the car park in front of the campsite. When driving on the campsite, particular attention must be paid to children playing.

The maximum speed is walking speed. It is also forbidden by the police to wash or repair vehicles on the campsite.

Failure to comply with the parking rules will result in the vehicle being banned from the site.

10. Prohibitions

It is forbidden to enter the neighbouring plots and fields around the campsite.

It is also forbidden to dig ditches and make campfires on the campsite and to attach ropes and lines to trees.

Water taps are only to be used for drinking water and not for playing.

Flowers or shrubs may only be planted in pots and not directly in the ground.

Fences, hedges and borders are not permitted on the pitches.

11. Pets

Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times, including on your own pitch.

Fighting dogs are generally prohibited here.

We urgently ask dog owners to observe these very simple rules on the campsite.

12. Sanitary facilities

It is in the interest of all guests to leave the sanitary area, showers and toilets as well as the sinks in the outdoor area clean. Clean. Children under the age of 6 may only be in the sanitary area when accompanied.

13. Swimming pool

Entry to the swimming pool is at your own risk. We accept no liability for lost or stolen

lost or stolen property.

The swimming pool is open from 15 June to 15 September from 13:00 to 18:00.

For health reasons, the outdoor area of the swimming pool remains closed in bad and cold weather.

closed. Children under the age of 8 and children without swimming experience may only enter the pool when accompanied by an adult in the swimming pool.

14. Waste disposal

A bin liner with a special sticker must be purchased at reception for the price of € 2.00 for waste disposal.

Glass, cans and paper do not belong in the rubbish bags and must be collected separately.

Cardboard boxes must be shredded. Residual waste such as camping chairs, tables, barbecues, air mattresses, tents or similar items are not disposed of by the campsite and must therefore be disposed of by yourself.

The residual waste can be deposited unsorted in the purchased rubbish bag on your own pitch and will be collected daily collected daily after 11.00 am. It is not permitted to leave the rubbish in another place or on another pitch.

15. Green waste

Green waste such as grass, leaves, tree cuttings etc. may not be disposed of on your own plot or elsewhere.

These must be disposed of in the designated area, see site plan.

16. Caravan pitch

Caravan roofs, equipment tents, terraces and awning floors must be agreed with the owner of the campsite.

It is permitted to set up a pavilion without side walls.

Mobile homes, caravans and awnings must be cleaned at least twice (in spring and autumn).

Furthermore, the lawn area on the pitch must be cut at least every 4-6 weeks.

In case of non-compliance, the area will be mowed by the campsite and charged accordingly.

When leaving the campsite, no objects such as chairs, tables etc. may be left on the pitch so that the lawns can be mowed.

17. Chemical toilet

Only dispose of chemical toilets in the designated room. This is located on the right at the front of the sanitary building.

18. Laundry

In the sanitary area there is a separate room with a washing machine, tumble dryer and ironing board.

The washing machine and tumble dryer are operated with Euro coins (\in 2, \in 1, \in 0.50, \in 0.20 and \in 0.10 coins).

You must provide your own washing powder.

19. Ban on drones

Camping is a holiday and relaxation.

And no guest wants to be disturbed by a drone in more ways than one, whether it has a camera on board or not.

20. Departure (not permanent guests)

Please vacate your pitch by 11.30 am on the day of departure.

If you wish to extend your stay until 18:00, we will only charge a surcharge of €5.00 per adult (please notify reception in advance).

Please make sure that you have not forgotten any of your belongings.

Please sign out at reception on departure.

Borrowed items must be returned to reception on the day of departure..

21. Payment (permanent camper)

Permanent campers are requested to pay their annual pitch rent as well as electricity, gas and water costs punctually on the specified date.

If payment is more than one week late, a reminder fee of € 10.00 will be charged.

We ask you to observe and respect this!

All camping rules are available at the reception.
